Dear Eagle Lake Property Owner,

Much hard and thorough work has gone into studying the Eurasian Water Milfoil that continues to spread in Eagle Lake. Some time ago, New York State indicated it wanted to use Eagle Lake as a demonstration project for treatment of milfoil with Flouridone, sometimes known by the trade name of Sonar. The appropriate applications were filed and our expectations were for \$100,000, the estimated cost of treating the Lake. For the past two years our hopes have met with disappointment. Last year, Eagle Lake was awarded only \$7,500 by the State of New York and this year just \$10,000.
