

Memoranda in Re - "Eagle Lake Dam."

1894 (about) Deed to Isaac Harris Lot 41 - dam site

Sept 13<sup>rd</sup> 1907 - Organizing permanently Eagle (Chion) Lake P.O. Assn.

July 26/13 Special meeting ass. to consider fully fishway dam - Letty to write McChin to come up & confer with Fish Committee in the matter.

Aug 27/13 McChin came to lake to confer on dam with view of conserving the fish - never said the dam was dangerous or unsafe, but did say it was inadequate (See letter)

Aug 30/13 Meeting acted on McChin's recommendation & instructed Letty to file application & plans for reconstructing fishway, with C.C. to prevail on approval <sup>proposed</sup> with construction of spill way - Letty also authorized to levy 1<sup>st</sup> assess of \$10.00 on each member for fund to be used for any expense incurred in matter of Dam.

Aug 30/13 Petition authorizing Letty to levy assessments for fund for dam signed by majority of Advisory Board.

Sept 4/13 Petition authorizing Letty to file application & plans with C.C. signed by majority Fish Committee.

Sept 4/13 Plans submitted by Alt. Ranger

Sept 17/13 Deed Farm L + D.L. to J.C. Newton

Oct 13/13 Proof of acknowledgement Leslie McChin N.Y. M.C. #80

Nov 14/13 q.a.m. deed to J.C. Newton, recorded, W.H. Roberts, C.R.

Aug 22/1914 E.O.L. phoned Newton of annual meeting of Adm. Com. of H.L. no proprietors offered. He said that he & Trust & Alder would form our Committee on Aug 25/1914.

Aug 22/1914 Annual meeting appointed, Hurd, Letty, Alder, E.O.L. to meet Newton & Terri's for amicable adjustment term

Aug 25/1914 Not met Committee at Hurd's Camp, bid price \$1000.00 on Lot 41 as only proposition. Committee refused to accept recommendation rejecting any <sup>bid</sup>.

Copy instruction of Committee to Secy. Tres. in Re-Reconstruction of Dam  
authorizing assessment levy

Eagle Lake N.Y. Aug 30/1913

To the Pres't & Secy. Tres.

Eagle (Chilson) Lake P.O. assn.

We, the undersigned members of your Advisory Board, constituting a majority of said Board, hereby authorize the Secy. Tres. to levy, enter & collect an assessment of (\$10<sup>00</sup>) Ten Dollars, from each & every member of the Association for the purpose of accumulating a fund for the preliminary & subsequent work in connection with the reconstruction of the dam at the outlet of Eagle Lake.

The above assessment is levied in accordance with art. IX Sect 3 of the By-laws of the Association.

I think been advising the judge Kellogg decided adversely to plaintiff's petition amended.

Feby. 5/1915 Conservation Commission returned one Blueprint, duplicate copy given by them to Ferris; did not return application for reconstruction Dam 786 as requested in letter Sept 23/1914. See letter C.C. on file.

Sept. 1918. Suit Flint vs. Range. compromised, ending litigation & settlement of Suit of Knob & Ferris costs p.d. by Range et al.

OCT. 7/1909 - Petition to P.M. GENL. To change name Eagle Cliff to Eagle Lake P.O. <sup>S FM. HITCHCOOK</sup>

OCT 11/1909 - 1<sup>ST</sup> HSST. P.M. GENL Replied it will be considered.

OCT. 26/1909 - NAME "EAGLE LAKE" P.O. granted - effective JAN. 1. 1910. as noted in Postoffice Bulletin Dec 1/1909.

1917-1918-1919 - Eagle Lake P.O. discontinued on the death of Nightingale + acc<sup>d</sup> 29/1916

MAY 1920 - Enclosed this Engleman Street to have post office re-opened #22651 ROUTE 7225. SCHROON LAKE TO TICONDEROGA.

NOV. 10/1920 EAGLE LAKE P.O. RE-ESTABLISHED - see letter of Postmaster General
