

Memoranda in Re - "Eagle Lake Dam"

1894 (about) Deed to Isaac Harris Lot 41 - dam site
Sept 13th 1907 - Organizing permanently Eagle (Chilam) Lake P.O. Assn.

July 26/1913. Special meeting ass. to consider fully fishway
down - Seely to write McKim to come up & confer
with Fish Committee in the matter.

Aug 27/13 McKim came to talk to confer on Dam with
view of concerning the fish - never said the dam
was dangerous or unsafe, but did say it
was inadequate (See letter)

Aug 30/13. Meeting called on McKim's recommendations
& instructed Seely, Treas. to file application & plans
for reconstructing spillway, with C.C. etc. proceed
on approval ^{proceed} with construction of spill way -
Seely also authorized to levy 1st assess of \$10.00 on
each member for funds to be used for any expense
incurred in matter of Dam.

Aug 30/13 Petition authorizing Seely Treas. to levy assessments
for fund for Dam signed by majority of Advisory Board.

Sept 4/13. Petition authorizing Seely Treas. to file application
& plans with C.C. signed by majority Fish Committee.

Sept 4/13 Plans submitted by Act. Ranger

Sept 17/13 Saw Farm L & D Co. to J.C. Newton

13/13. Proof of acknowledgment Seely McKim N.P.M.C. #80

Aug 22/1914 E.O.L. phoned Newton of annual meeting of Assn. & asked if he had
any propositions to offer. He said that he & Ferris & Dudley would see
our Committee on Aug 25/1914

Aug 22/1914 Annual meeting appointed, Herd, Seely, Third, Alder & Ho
to meet Newton & Ferris for amicable adjustment tomorrow

Aug 25/1914 Not J met Committee at Herd's Camp, set price of \$1000.00 on Lot 41
as only proposition. Committee referred to Assn. recommended rejection ^{See by any 2}

Copy Instruction of Committee to Secy Treas. in Re-reconst of Dam
authorizing assessment levy

Eagle Lake W. Aug 30/1913

To the Pres & Secy Treas.
Eagle (Chilam) Lake P.O. Assn.

We, the undersigned members of your Advisory Board
constituting a majority of said Board, hereby author-
ize the Secy Treas to levy, enter & collect an assessment
of (\$10⁰⁰) Ten Dollars, from each & every member of
the Association for the purpose of accumulating a
fund for the preliminary & subsequent work in
connection with the reconstruction of the dam at the
outlet of Eagle Lake.

The above assessment is levied in accordance with
Art. IX Sect 3 of the Bylaws of the Association.

Eagle Lake W. Sept 1/1913

To the Pres. & Secy Treas.

reconstruction of the Dam at the outlet of Eagle Lake,
with the Conservation Commission and that work on
same can be expedited, we the undersigned members

at a meeting on Aug 30th 1913 to proceed with the
matter of reconstructing the Dam, do hereby author-
ize the Secy Treas. to take up the filing of the applica-
tion & the construction of the Dam as soon as
possible.

Sept 23/1914. Litchy wrote Conservat Commission demanding return Blueprints & applicat for reconstructing Dam #786.

Nov. 7/1914. Case to come up for hearing at Post/Honory Special Term of Court

Jan 30/15. Litchy's letter advising the Judge Kellogg decided adversely to plaintiffs' petition amended.

Feb. 5/1915 Conservat Commission returned one Blueprint, duplicate copy given by them to Ferris; did not return application for reconstruction Dam 786 as requested in letter Sept 23/1914. See letter C.C. on file.

Sept. 1918. Suit Hunt vs. Runge. compromised, ending litigation & settlement of Suit of Hunt & Ferris. costs p.d. by Runge et al

JAN. 30/1901 - Summer Post office "Eagle Lake" established (Creek), MAY 2/1901. " " " " changed to "Eagle Cliff"

1903-1904 - "Eagle Lake P.O." Hamilton Co. N.Y. discontinued

OCT. 7/1909 - Petition to P.M. GENL. ^{F.P. HITCHCOCK} to change name Eagle Cliff to Eagle Lake P.O.

OCT 11/1909 - P.M. GENL. replied "it will be considered"

OCT. 26/1909 - NAME "EAGLE LAKE" P.O. granted - effective JAN. 1. 1910. as noted in Postoffice Bulletin Dec 1/1909.

1917-1918-1919 - Eagle Lake P.O. discontinued on 1/2 death Geo. Northaling ^{Dec 7/1916}

MAY 1920 - Endeavour of the Congressman Sweet to have postoffice re-opened

NOV. 10/1920 EAGLE LAKE P.O. RE-ESTABLISHED - see letter of Asst. Postmaster General MRS. Fannie S. Parker Postmaster - ~~office~~ office not opened until

JULY 8/1924 - EAGLE LAKE P.O. opened for summer Dorothy M. Rice Asst. P.M.

" 19/1922 " " " " " " " " by Robt. Glenn Jr. as Asst. P.M.

" 1923 " " " " " " " " closed as it had no business

" 1923 Mrs. Fannie R. Parker, P.M. resigned. Asst. Postmaster applied for application as P.M. of Eagle Lake (P.O. NOT OPERATED IN 1923 - TOY LATE PM 1924)

Sept 10/1923 James D. Glenn Post Box 24 Schenectady appointed Postmaster to succeed Fannie Parker resigned

SAT. SEPT 13/24 P.O. CLOSED FOR 24 HRS. STAMPS SENT ALL P.O. SUPPLIES & RECORDS TO DEPT. AS INSTRUCTED - REG. MAIL TO CENTRAL P.M. NYCL

THURS. SEPT 18/1924 HOTEL BURNT TO GROUND - 2 AM. POST OFFICE DISCONTINUED - P.M. JAS. D. GLENN - RESIGNED (ACCEPTED)

FALL 1924 OR) SPR. 1925 EAGLE LAKE P.O. DISCONTINUED - GLENN'S RESIGNATION ACCEPTED
