Stubing for a permit to fill in waters of Eagle Lake, Town of Ticonderoga, Essex County, New York Dear Sirs: I wish to register my opposition to any permit to fill in the waters of Eagle Lake, and in particular to Mr. Stubing's request to build 150 feet of wooden cribbing plus 1000 cubic yards of fill, in the waters of the lake. I suggest that if it is a question or covering the trash that has been discarded on the banks, that he clean this up, as it would take very little effort. He has at present an adequate parking lot, and I am sure if he is willing to pay for it there is adjacent property which could be purchased for additional parking facilities. This cribbing and fill would damage fish spawning grounds, would be unsightly, unnatural and objectionable when viewed from the lake. This lake is in the present process of becoming polluted, so witness the intensive growth of underwater weed. My family and I have been a property owner on the lake since 1890, and we feel strongly that anything that alters the charac-ter of this body of water is objectionable. May I ask who Harland H.
