Dear Sir, My letter is in response to your letter of May 15, 1972, which you brought to my attention the feeling of the Eagle Lake Property Owners' Association. At the annual meeting of the Eagle Lake Property Owners' Association it was decided that I should write to you to express the wishes of the approximately 65 members of the association.

It was decided that the section of Route 73 from Ghilson to beyond the western end of Eagle Lake should be to the south of the present route to avoid damaging any of the residences along the present route and to avoid filling in any part of the lake.
