Dear Mr. Lodge;-

We have just about completed arrangements to have Mr. Flint bring action against Mess. Newton & Ferris in the New York Supreme Court to force them to restore the dam and bring back conditions at the lake as they were previous to their destruction of the spillway.

In order to get this action started Mr. Hurd and I guaranteed to Flint the fee of \$100.00, would be paid him by the property owners. Mr. Runge agreed that the action be filed in his name as plaintiff and as soon as Flint gets several other affidavits from some of the other property owners, he will at once proceed with the action.

In order not to delay this action any longer I would appreciate your sending him your affidavit as a property owner in the event he sends you a copy for your signature.

I trust that he may succeed in his action against Newton, so that we may get this situation cleared before we all assemble at the lake this summer.

I have engaged accommodations to leave here on June 30th and get to the lake July 1st.

Thus far, Mr. Hurd, Mr. Runge and I have together advanced Mr. Flint part of the \$100.00 fee, to enable him to go to the Essex County Court to enter action.
