I have now received a letter from the Commission notifying me of a public hearing on this matter scheduled in Ti on July 9th, and also copy of order of bñsness etc for this hearing.


Doubtless you also have this and are familiar with it.

Has anyone considered the possibility that this proposed fill might also be used to hide the knstallation of a septic tank and drainage field for that group of cabins on the point which I judge would be the Western end of the proposed fill.
