Some time ago, I wrote to you concerning my definite belief that Eagle Lake is much too high; that there should be a dam with provis ion for r aising or lowering the waterlevel, not this solid one put in last spring by the atate. The water is now so high hat t he area where we have used for a swimming beach and warked on our small baot (e-cano e and saliboat), is now und er two inches of water. This boathou e was built before 1900 and until this year has s erved us well; but now the waves are beginning to ~~rot~~ ^{rot} the fl oorboards where we shelter out small mot-or boat.

On July 5th t he Eagle Lake Proper ty Owners held their annual meeting. t her e were soem fifty people here (including guests) but many more have said they would have come except for the threatened r a in. And the rains did come. However we decid ed to send out a written ballot to all property owners, to be mailed on July 15 with a two weeks reply date as to whether we should keep the 1935 ^{well} for which mos t people have planned their activities. Mr. George Dela ncy has no doubt written to you that he likes the present level. He He ha s been here only seven ye ars and has no plans to stay here since his house is for sale. He has stated that there are only five boathou es on The lake I include a list of persons know n to me who are greatly inconven ienced by this high wa ter. We are aware tha t the re is pre sently five inches of water going over the dam, but that is not enought to save these inst allations that ha ve been here f or many yea rs. We understand that we can hope f or a new dam next spring and sincerely hope it will be in accordance with the wishes of the majority of the landowners here.
