Gentlemen:-

With reference to the conference which you gentlemen, had with Mr. Hurd, Mr. Alden and myself at Eagle Lake, on July 9th, when you said you would advise us shortly as to the possibility of adjusting the matter of the spillway, amicably, we have up to the present, had no reply from you.

During this period of some sixteen days, I have been compelled, at no little expense, to adjust some of my riparian structures to the present level of the water in the lake and to clear the shores of dangerous obstructions, in order to use my boats, this summer.

Other property owners whom I advised of the conference we had, are inquiring daily concerning the situation; I would, therefore, be pleased to hear from you as soon as possible, if you have any proposition which you desire me to present to the members of our
