I would appreciate your perusing the enclosed correspondence, starting with the penultimate paragraph of Mr. Sussdorf's letter of October 20, 1978.

All we of the Eagle Lake Property Owner's Association are asking is for someone to take a sample of the floating objects in Eagle Lake, Essex County, and tell us who is correct: Mr. Smith of New York, Mr. Norvell of Connecticut, or neither of the above.

Naturally, our concern is that these objects could be symptomatic of a change in the nutrition level of the lake caused by the addition of phosphorous. If this is in fact correct, then we want to take whatever steps - together with the offices of the D.E.C. - which are necessary to reduce and/or eliminate this situation.

I would sincerely appreciate either your checking this out for us or sending this correspondence on to someone who could.
