This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of July 18, 1971. We will very carefully consider your remarks and suggestions, together with the views presented at the Informational Meeting held on July 15, 1971. With regards to the possibility of going north of Eagle Lake, the Department has previously investigated that possibility, and after studying it decided it was not feasible. It's infeasibility stems from a combination of terrain, traffic flow, and environmental problems. When all data has been compiled and evaluated, the Department will make a recommendation to the Federal Highway Administration for location approval of one of the alternates. Our recommendation and the Federal Highway Administration's subsequent action will be published in the local newspapers. Following this, the opportunity will be afforded for a second public hearing for the purpose of discussing alternate alignments within the chosen location.
