Dear Sir: I have your letter of Sept. 2nd before me as a note you have written the Farmers Loan & Trust Co., Trustees for the Isaac Harris Estate, who own the land on which ~~the~~ it is intended to reconstruct the dam at the outlet of Eagle Lake. The writer had hoped it possible that your Commission could order the Dam built by the owners of the land, and ^{we believe} the members of an Association would cheerfully pay their respective pro-rata of the expense of reconstruction. It may be that you wrote the Farmers Loan & Trust Co. to this effect, as the writer had discussed & suggested when you were at the Lake. As they are not members of our Association, even though being largely interested in property & lands on Eagle Lake, we would have no way of inducing them to pay their ^{share} ~~pro-rata~~ of the expense of reconstruction. ^{Besides, this one of further property owners on Eagle Lake, not members of the Association, are also interested in the dam.} We therefore trust that they can be induced to build the dam.
