Yours of September 15th received. As I understand
it the dam is on property owned by the Estate of Mrs. Isaac
Harris, so that they will either have to build the dam or
give their approval therefor.

I wrote the Farmers Loan & Trust Company concerning
this when I heard from you, but I have not heard from them
and I will write again.

Your plans received which state that the walls are
to be carried to a firm foundation bed. This should go down
at least to hard firm soil and a cut-off wall all around should
be carried to a depth of some four feet, so that the water will
not have a straight line to work its way under the dam. I
have asked the Farmers Loan & Trust Company to communicate with
you in this matter.

Will you also get up a little specification for this
to go with it, as the law calls for plans and specifications to
