I hope you will pardon my delay  
in reply to your letter of September 20.

I have from Mr. Odell a brief  
review of the situation at Eagle Lake, which I  
attach herewith. I want to point out to you that  
in the forage fish group - suckers and minnows -  
the supply is meager and this in itself should  
indicate no further stocking of predacious species  
until the minnow life becomes at least abundant.  
Otherwise, as you can see, your food and game fish  
that you wish to angle for, will prey upon each  
other.
