Dear Mr Runge:-

A letter from Luthy just recd states he has deposited same in the funds of the Assn. from whence they cannot emerge until some far off meeting of the Assn. I have just written him that as the Assn is not connected with your suit, that he has no right to appropriate the Company's money for Assn purposes when their letter to him of which they sent me a copy, expressly stated that this in the check was for the purpose of this suit.
