HIKING SCHEDULE 1974

The following schedule is to be undertaken on an individual responsibility basis.

The Property Owners Association is not sponsoring the following hikes. Those interested in any or all should meet at the designated meeting place and those there at the suggested departure time will then start out on the hike. Each person going, will be his or her own guide and be responsible for himself.

Saturday, July 20; 9:30 AM; at Otter Pond.
Departure Point: Boat landing at state trail marker on south shore of Eagle Lake, south of the causeway.
Length: .5 mile up hill. Good beginners hike. Can be completed up and back before lunch.

Saturday, July 27; 9:30 AM; Little Skiff.
Departure Point: Old Hunter farm off of Stoney Lonesome, which branches west off the Ironville Road (Corduoy).
This is a very easy hike - not a great deal of verticle but wonderful view of Eagle Lake and off to the west.
Unmarked trail, so it is necessary for someone who knows the way to be on this hike.
Easily completed before lunch, but great place also to enjoy a picnic lunch.

Saturday, August 3; 9:30 AM; Knob Mountain.
Departure Point: Old Hunter farm off Stoney Lonesome. More difficult. Trail unmarked, so necessary for someone who's been up Knob to be along.
Highly rewarding with views to west, down sheer west face to Knob Pond and if day is clear, Lake Champlain can be seen to the Northeast. Picnic lunch suggested.

Saturday, August 10; 9:30 AM; Treadway.
Departure Point: East shore Putnam Pond at the end of road leading in from Chilson.
This is quite a challenge and an all day hike so bring picnic lunch. Trail is yellow marked around Putnam Pond, start off to the left facing the pond. At junction bear right to Mud Pond Trail. Treadway bears left off Mud Pond Trail.
Well marked, so no guide necessary.
