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## STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- This permit shall at all times be subject to the approval of the Regional Land Manager and may be suspended or revoked at any time with due cause.
- 2. The permittee shall notify the Regional Land Manager at least 48 hours prior to commencing use and upon completion of use.
- The activities authorized under this permit shall not interfere with normal administration of the area by the Department.
- No damage will be done to State land, State facilities or boundary or survey markers.
- 5. The permittee is responsible for any inadvertant or deliberate damage caused by the exercise of this permit and will be held responsible for restoration, rehabilitation or repair at the permittee's expense.
- No trees or other vegetation shall be cut, disturbed or removed unless specifically authorized by the Regional Land Manager.
- 7. The State land covered by this permit shall be kept free of litter and debris and be left in a condition satisfactory to the Regional Land Manager at the expiration of the permit or on completion of activities authorized by the permit.
- 8. Permittee shall keep fish screen free of debris at all times.
- Permittee shall regulate the water level of Eagle Lake within plus or minus four inches referenced to the gauge on the state bridge.
