Dear Mr. Lutny:--

Enclosed find copy of deed of lot #41 to Newton & Ferris.
I have the certified copy from the Essex County Clerk's office.

I have not been able to see Mr. McKimm as yet of the
Conservation Commission. Do you not think that it would be
best for us to request the commission, either individually or
collectively to notify us of any intention of changing the
level of our Lake? This would not put any of us on record
as opposed to raising the Lake, which might hinder us at a
later date from either collecting damages or seeking a new level.
I think that if Newton & Ferris attempt any operations on the
Dam without notifying the Commission, we would be justified to
obstruct their actions either physically or legally.

I will endeavor to find out from the Commission if they
will notify us provided Newton & Ferris ask permission to
change the level. After hearing from them, I will report to
you. In the meantime I await your suggestion as to whether
we protest against changing the level or simply ask for noti-

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fication. I believe that it would be well if you or I would get in communication with the Supervisor of the town of Ticonderoga, (if he now be alive) who was in office at the time the town of Ticonderoga started to take care of the road over the Dam. If I recollect correctly, Mr. Harris informed me that he had arranged with the town to take care of the road over the Dam, thus relieving him of the expense, which he had been subject to for keeping the Dam in repair.

C. H. Doolittle of Ticonderoga was in the Store yesterday and he said that any records which the Road Commissioner might have, would probably have been turned over to the town Supervisor. He thought that Mr. Bascom, the hard-ware dealer, might have been Supervisor at that time.
