

I believe it would be a mistake to apply to the Court for an order commanding N.& F. to restore the dam - I suspicion that is just what they expect and want us to do, as then they could insist on certain concessions as to level to the advantage of their Lot 41.

If we can get an injunction, N.& F. will be forced eventually to come to us to raise the level of the Lake, otherwise, their lot will be valueless. We could thus have them in our power. They would hardly expect us to get an injunction, but are rather expecting us to appeal to the Court for a restoration of the old level of the Lake and then in Court force us to adopt any level most suitable to make their lot more valuable for cottage sites, and if the level were raised above the old level, we would be forced to change all our riparian structures at our own expense.
