My dear Mr. Lodge: I have been expecting to hear from you with regard to the removal of the Cape Lake Dam, which Mr. Lundy tells me you have taken up somewhat with the C. C. I have had considerable correspondence with Mr. Moore, Com. of Div. of Inland Waters, who reported to me that the C had apparently decided Mr. Weston of Ti to construct a suitable dam there. Mr. N. Tolson, under our ass. lately that Mr. Sherman of the Div. Inland Waters (Chief Engineer) I believe, had advised that Weston take out the dam entirely. This seems rather strange in the face of the orders of Mr. Moore to Weston that such dam be rebuilt.

As you know our request to the Fisheries Division of the Commission as that Mr. Dean State Fish Commission who sent Mr. Lundy to me, not on the removal of any dam, but simply to tell us whether Cape Lake was on the old dam was intended to conserve our game fish, give them up among grounds which there fine loss during high water. You will recall that Mr. Weston first brought the subject of a new dam of concrete with wide spillways instead of the contemplated fishway. We then agreed to the change & Mr. Dean drew the blue prints which Mr. Weston is to use to build it so we would go ahead.

I should advise you to tell Mr. Dean to hope just what happened to us for asking advice from the C. on the best way to save our fish. That is all we talked to the C. about.
