

FIRE SAFETY SUGGESTIONS FOR OUR CAMPS AND WOODS

USE SAFETY MATCHES ONLY

Store these in covered metal containers, out of children's reach.

PROVIDE ADEQUATE ASH TRAYS

USE METAL WASTE BASKETS, TRASH CANS, AND CANDLE HOLDERS

NEVER CARRY LIGHTED LAMPS.. ( USE FLASHLIGHTS ! )

When lighted, lamps should remain in place on STEADY TABLE or on bracket, away from curtains, bedding, and clothes racks.

FILL LAMPS OUTSIDE..USE WICKS OF CORRECT SIZE..TRIM FOR EVEN FLAME

TURN LAMPS LOW TO LIGHT...INCREASE GRADUALLY AS CHMINEY WARMS UP

Smoking lamps are inefficient and dangerous.

NEVER STORE KEROSENE IN GLASS CONTAINERS

STORE GASOLINE IN APPROVED GASOLINE SAFETY CANS ONLY

NEVER USE KEROSENE OR GASOLINE AS AN AID IN LIGHTING FIRES

PORTABLE KEROSENE OR GASOLINE HEATERS CONSIDERED INSURANCE HAZZARDS

THEIR USE MAY CAUSE LOSS OF INSURANCE

IF you do use..Follow Manufacturer's instructions..Keep clean & in good repair..Use correct replacement parts & recommended fuel.

Watch for smoke or high flame..Place, to avoid overturning.....

Place away from combustible materials....Refill Outside.

ELECTRIC OR GAS HEATERS SHOULD BEAR UNDERWRITER'S (UL) LABEL

CLEAN ASH PITS FREQUENTLY SO NO ASHES HIT CLEAN-OUT DOORS

KEEP COMBUSTIBLE MATERIAL AWAY FROM CLEAN-OUT DOORS...CHECK OFTEN

NEVER PUT ASHES IN COMBUSTIBLE CONTAINERS

ALWAYS WET ASHES BEFORE DUMPING

CLEAN CHMINEYS AND STOVE PIPES YEARLY..CHECK FOR CRACKS

INSULATE WOODEN WALLS IF NEAR STOVE, STOVE PIPE, HEATER

NEVER HANG CURTAINS, CLOTHING, etc. NEAR STOVE, STOVE PIPE, HEATER

USE SCREENED OR COVERED CONTAINER FOR BURNING TRASH

KEEP FIRE PLACES SCREENED

SCREEN CHMINEYS TO AVOID SPARKS ON FLAMMABLE ROOFS AND IN WOODS

PLAN AND PRACTICE EVACUATION OF CAMP IN ANTICIPATION OF FIRE EMERGENCY

IN WOODS..BREAK YOUR MATCHES..CRUSH YOUR SMOKES..DROWN YOUR CAMPFIRE

FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT AT EACH CAMP SHOULD INCLUDE

- . Approved Fire Extinguishers, conveniently located, near hazzards
- . Garden Hose or filled water barrel and buckets.
- . Safe Ladders for rescue and reaching highest flammable rooftop.
- . A Back-pack Pump & Fire Swatter (wet broom, wet burlap bag, etc)
