Thank you for your letter received on July 22, 2005 explaining the method for the placement of the benthic mats for the above-mentioned project. Pursuant to the provisions of the NYS Environmental Conservation Law, no permit will be required for the placement of benthic mats using 5/8 inch rebar, or the hand harvesting of Eurasian Water Milfoil in Eagle Lake. As a result of this determination, we have withdrawn your permit application.
