Eagle Lake Membership and Community Communications

Several information documents have been prepared as part of ELPOI's outreach education and Lake Management Plan. These have been distributed to its membership and the community at large. They are detailed below and samples are included for your information.

- 1) The membership of the ELPOI maintain a web site at *www.Eaglelake1.org* and are this year Celebrating 100 Years of Responsible Lake Stewardship 1907 2007
- 2) A "How to Identify Eurasian Water Milfoil" handout was prepared in 2006 for distribution to lake membership. This was done in anticipation of the hand harvest program as part of the 2006 Invasive Species Eradication grant application.
- 3) "Aquatic Plants in Eagle Lake a Pictorial Guide" was prepared in 2006 to provide diver training and for lake membership information. The plant list was compiled from Darrin Freshwater Institute surveys of Eagle Lake in 1932,1989, and 1998.
- 4) An "Eagle Lake Newsletter –Spring 2007" was prepared to up date ELPOI membership and the general community of past years and future activities. Distribution was to over 150 individuals by both paper and electronic copy.
- 5) An "Underwater Milfoil Swim Over Eagle Lake Video" was prepared in 2007 as a result of the many questions that the public has asked ELPOI members. The questions usually relate to what the plant looks like, growth size and density and surrounding terrain. This video captures some of this for education of the public. It was filmed over one of several of the largest patches of milfoil in Eagle Lake. This is one of the patches that the Towns and ELPOI hope to do a site-specific treatment of with the herbicide Renovate.
