B) The Town of Chesterfield (Essex County) reported on setting up a tax district for their lake to fund projects.

C) East Shore Schroon Lake Association reported on insurance concerns for lake associations.

B) should we put Adopt-a-Resource agreement for the dam on our web page? C) should we notify truck companies to be cautions around sharp curves when excessive speeds can cause weight shifts of cargo?
