It was gratifying to learn that in the reply to Al Runge's letter to the Department of Environmental Conservation, it was stated that Eagle Lake has not had any ill effects due to acid rain.

I believe that before we train anyone for testing the leach beds, we advise all members of the Association of the harm that occurs when phosphate, etc., are emptied into the lake waters.

I would suggest a newsletter be sent to all members concerning the "algae and phosphate problems", and remarking that all the leach beds on the lake may have to be tested.

When can we arrange an Executive Committee meeting to pass on and execute whatever recommendations are made?
