

MINUTES OF THE ELEVENTH ANNUAL MEETING OF THE
EAGLE (CHILSON) LAKE PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION
HELD AT EAGLE LAKE, ESSEX CO., N.Y. ON THURSDAY AUG 1-1918
