

MINUTES OF THE TWELFTH ANNUAL MEETING OF THE
EAGLE (CHILSON) LAKE PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION
HLD AT EAGLE LAKE, ESSEX CO. N.Y. ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 1ST 1919.

The twelfth annual meeting of the Eagle (Chilson) Lake Property Owners' Assn. held on Friday Aug. 1st, 1919 at "Eden" Lodge, Eagle Lake, Essex Co. N.Y. was called to order by Pres. Fitzgerald at 3 P.M. and closed pursuant to notices of said meeting having been sent to the members in accordance with Art. VIII Sect I. of the By Laws of the Association.

Upon call by the Secy. mas. the following members were enrolled as present viz.: President Fitzgerald, Miss Cowan, Miss Harris, ~~Harris~~ Lodge, in person, Mrs. Knud represented by proxy to Mr. Knud, Mrs. Lansing by proxy to Mr. Paris, Mrs. Range & Mrs. Schmidlapp & Mr. Mocks by proxy to Mr. Luttry, this enrollment constituting a quorum & making the meeting competent to proceed with the business for which it was called.

The Secy. Luttry then read the minutes of the last meeting which were unanimously approved.

The written annual report of the Secy. mas. being presented & read, on motion duly made & carried the report was approved as read & ordered filed.

The annual dues for the association were then revised by the Secy. mas. from following numbers

one of Bass for 1919- being auto tire 100 & engine, 50. - won \$785 was validated after being heard, ordered to pay sum out of G. Fund.

The meeting then proceeded with its annual election of officers & committees to serve for the ensuing year.

On motion duly made & carried the following members were elected for their respective offices and so declared viz:-

" Vice Pres -	Mr. Wm J. Lodge
" Secy. mas. -	Mr. Ed. Luttry.

On motion duly made & carried the following members were elected to constitute the respective Committees & so behaved viz:-

Miss Knud, Lodge & Harris & P. Fitzgerald Coff. as Adm'g Committee
" Luttry, Wicks & St. Fitzgerald Coff. as Fisheries Committee

The following resolution was then offered and carried by unanimous vote. that:- The Secy. mas. be authorized to pay out of the general fund any expense that may be incurred with respect to ordering, transporting or planting of fish fry for the lake, as they may be delivered from time to time.

On motion duly made & carried the members were agreed on having Mr. Albert Ward use his influence with Senator Teller or any other Assembly man to endeavor to have a Law passed prohibiting the sale of fish taken from Eagle Lake.

There being no further business, an motion duly made carried the meeting adjourned.
