

MINUTES OF THE SIXTEENTH ANNUAL MEETING OF THE
EAGLE LAKE PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION
HELD AT "EDNET" LODGE, EAGLE LAKE, ESSEX CO. N.Y. ON AUG 4/1923.

The sixteenth annual meeting of the Eagle Lake Property Owners' Assn. held on Saturday Aug 4/1923 at "Ednet" Lodge Eagle Lake, Essex Co. N.Y. was called to order by Mr. Emil Range, as Pres. pro tem. in the absence of the President & Vice President, at 3 P.M. Standard time and held in pursuance to notices of said meeting sent to the members in accordance with Art. Vth Sec. 1. of the By-Laws of the Association.

Upon call by the Secy-Treas. the following members were enrolled as present viz:—
Pres. pro tem. Emil Range representing Mrs. Range
Miss Conran, Wilson Harris, O'Doherty, present in person and Mr. Geo. E. Ward representing Mrs. Ward and Mr. Gariis representing Mrs. Dorsing, this enrollment constituting a quorum and making the meeting competent to proceed with the business for which it was called.

The Secy-Treas. then read the minutes of the last meeting which were unanimously approved.
A communication from Mr. Cody of the N.Y. State Conservation Commission with reference to fish fry was read & ordered filed.

The written annual report of the Secy-Treas. being read, on motion duly made & unanimously carried, it was accepted, approved as read & ordered filed.

The written report of the Committee on Fisheries which was then read was ordered filed.
On motion made & carried Mr. Gariis and Miss Conran were appointed as a Committee to draft resolutions on the death of members Mrs. M. J. Schmidlapp & Mrs. Edward Range and requested to mail a copy of said resolutions to the families of the deceased.

Whereas:-

Mrs. Margaret J. Schmidlapp and Mrs. Edward Range, members of the Eagle Lake Property Owners' Assn. and long identified with the interests of Eagle Lake have been taken from us by death

Be it Resolved:-

That this association extend to their family its sympathy and further be it resolved:-

That a copy of these resolutions be sent to the families of the deceased and that a copy be spread upon the minutes of the Association.

The following resolution offered by member Harris was adopted unanimously and the Secy. has instructed to mail a copy to the N.Y. State Fish Game & Forest Ranger - Comr. S. Rogers, Secy., Executive office, 39 Stewart Bldg. Albany.

"Resolved that the Conservation Law be so amended that no pike, pike-perch, or yellow perch which are taken out of eagle lake, Essex Co. N.Y. shall be sold or offered for sale.

"Resolved that no bass or trout which are taken out of Goodneek lake, Essex Co. N.Y. shall be sold or offered for sale.

The motion made carried the duly cast the ballot & elected Mr. Dan Ford & S. A. James as members of the Association.

The annual dues were then received by the Secy. from the following members.

The meeting then proceeded with the annual election of Officers & Committees to serve for the ensuing year. The motion duly made & carried the following members were elected for their respective offices and so declared, viz:- Pres. Mr. Albert Reed, Vice Pres. Mr. Edmund J. Dodge, Secy. Treas. Mr. Edmund J. Dodge

The motion duly made & carried the following members were elected to constitute the respective Committees and so declared viz:- Mess. Reed, Dodge, Harris & Pest. Reed, Ex off. as Advisory Commr. Mess. Kirby, Dodge, FitzGerald & Pest. Reed & off. as Fisheries Commr. Pest. Albert Reed was named as delegate for our association to the N.Y. State Fish Game & Forest Dept.

The motion duly made & carried Mess. Kirby & Civil Runge were named as a Committee to take steps in discouraging undesirable companies being permitted to meet on the Nickles property.

The Secy. Treas. was then instructed to re-imburse Mr. Albert Reed in the amount of \$800 for the transportation of a consignment of bass fish (600) and one of lake trout (10 cans (7500)) from the N.Y. Cons. Commission which were packed in Eagle Lake & Goodneek respectively. The Secy. Treas. was also ordered to remit the annual membership dues of \$250 for the year from Sept 1/23 to Sept 1/24 to the City slate Fish Game & Forest Ranger. (Comr. S. Rogers, Secy. 312 Capitol Bldg. Syracuse, N.Y.) being \$25 per member.

There being no further business on agenda made & carried the meeting adjourned.
