Thank you for your letter of March 9, 1974. At this time I do not have any further information to report on the proposed improvements to Route 74 in the vicinity of Eagle Lake.

Your assessment of the results of the Transportation Bond Issue is quite accurate. Without a guaranteed level of funding over a period of years, it is quite difficult for us to project when we might be proceeding with the necessary improvements on this road.

I will be only too happy to keep you advised of any developments when they do occur. I felt that the meeting which we had last Labor Day weekend was an excellent one, and when we are at a point where we would have some definite proposals on paper I would propose that we have another similar meeting so that all concerned residents of the area could review our proposals as well as provide alternate ones which they might like considered.
