This grant application seeks funding to help support ELPOI's testing of environmental water quality. ELPOI continues to support the public outreach for education of lake issues and our ongoing efforts to monitor, maintain and document the water quality of Eagle Lake, which is located in the Towns of Ticonderoga and Crown Point NY.

\* Proposal Detail

The proposal is a request to assist ELPOI in covering the costs associated with the continued testing and monitoring of Eagle Lake waters in conjunction with NYS CSLAP (Citizen State Lake Assessment Program) and NYS FOLA (Federation of Lakes). This is a volunteer program, in which residents and members of ELPOI collect water samples over a 12 week period for testing, analysis and reporting performed at NYS DEC facilities. In addition to NYS CSLAP and NYS FOLA testing, ELPOI performs supplemental testing for Fecal and chemical analysis through the Darrin Freshwater Institute.

In addition to water testing, ELPOI maintains signage at both the boat launch and campground to communicate the importance of NYS DEC and APA's message of 'Clean, Drain, Dry,' which is a program to prevent the spread of invasive species which can contaminate water and affect water quality.

Both current and past water quality documentation is posted to our website where comparison can be made to the health of the lake. Additionally, lake monitoring and water quality is communicated regularly to the members of ELPOI via our newsletters.

- \* Expected Outcomes Water testing performed under NYS CSLAP and NYS FOLA as well as Fecal and chemical analysis will provide a snapshot of the health and environmental quality of the water in Eagle Lake.

Results will be communicated to ELPOI membership and available for the public to view via our website.

- \* Evaluation Current and past data from our water testing is reviewed by our board and posted to the ELPOI website. This is done in conjunction with the historical review and comparison performed with the data received from the DEC CSLAP data and provides ELPOI with a yearly report that can be used to determine the health of the lake. ELPOI has a yearly meeting to discuss issues facing the lake. During this time the health of the lake is discussed including feedback from lake residents.

This letter is in response to your telephone request for a copy of your organization's determination letter. This letter will take the place of the copy you requested.

Our records indicate that a determination letter issued in July of 1996 granted your organization exemption from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. That letter is still in effect.

Based on information subsequently submitted, we classified your organization as one that is not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code because it is an organization described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi).

This classification was based on the assumption that your organization's operations would continue as stated in the application. If your organization's sources of support, or its character, method of operations, or purposes have changed, please let us know so we can consider the effect of the change on the exempt status and foundation status of your organization.

Your organization is required to file Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax, only if its gross receipts each year are normally more than \$25,000. If a return is required, it must be filed by the 15th day of the fifth month after the end of the organization's annual accounting period. The law imposes a penalty of \$20 a day, up to a maximum of \$10,000, when a return is filed late, unless there is reasonable cause for the delay.


